

### Post and Pole Producer Map






### Discussion on Information Discovered during the Survey

- > Communication between producers on industry practices across supply regions could help all regions.



#### Percent distribution of the labor force\*





#### Leading Indicator of Remodeling Activity - Fourth Quarter 2023



#### Year-to-year production changes for selected fruit and tree nuts, 2022-23f




2022-23f percent change in total production


#### 5-market steer price




# **Cost Comparison**

# Sharing Information on Industry Standards

Subject: Regional Provisions RO-C6.825# - Scaling as Presented (Sales by Load Count)


To: Forest Supervisors

Enclosed for your immediate use is the following regional contract provision. This new provision is to be used in conjunction with scaled (3S, 6 or 13) contracts in which a suitable scaling facility is unavailable and when it is determined scaling by load count is an appropriate method of measurement. Volume removed will be paid based on a predetermined conversion factor (tons/load) based on maximum gross vehicle weight and purchaser equipment configurations. Per B6.84, Accountability Agreement – Load Count Timber Sale will be signed and effective prior to hauling. This provision is approved for use on sales appraised at \$4.00/Ton or less.

Total sale volumes for load count sales will be calculated using Cruise Processing. Work with your Regional Timber Measurement and Sale Administration Specialist to determine truck volumes and weights by trailer configuration. Please confirm that adequate and updated weight factors are available for the products being sold. In addition, during the early rollout and use of load count, work with your Regional Specialist's to determine if a load count weight sale is the right tool for use.
